### 1. Energy Efficient/Space Efficient:

### 2. Cool Finish:

Indicates minimum temperature starting two weeks after the beginning of short days. Please note that a crop grown cooler requires more time to finish (4 to 7 days), and will have smaller bracts and darker color (for example, white may turn cream-yellow). Toward the end of the crop (two weeks prior to shipping), slowly lower the temperature for green-leaved varieties to 65°F (18°C) day/night and dark green-leaved varieties to 63°F (17°C) day/night.
