The medium-compact habit of Funtopia Pink and Funtopia Blue makes it great for hanging baskets and tabletop centerpiece bowls. The tie-dye-like pattern is fresh and modern to attract attention to a garden, and the semi-double flowers are whimsical and sweet. It is great for mixing in as a textural element with other sun-loving plants for custom patio combos.

Dahlia Venti™ Magenta + White Eye – Venti is a vigorous dahlia series for gardens or large-size patio containers. It makes an excellent thriller in mixes when paired with other sun-loving plants. The new Magenta + White Eye is a bicolor pink-and-white stunner that pops against deep green garden space. Dahlias attract pollinators, too, for added enjoyment outdoors. Venti's double-flowered form is the perfect landing pad for butterflies.
